The aim of the Toy Library

The aim of the Cottingham Children's Centre Toy Library is to provide a quality Toy Library service for families, groups and childminder's in the local area, with a wide range of fun, stimulating and educational toys.

The Toy Library is available to all parents and carers of children under 5 years of age.

Qualified and experienced Children's Centre staff are available to offer advice and support on age appropriate toys.

There is a catalogue system available which enables the borrower to choose a toy and reserve it.

Toys are so expensive these days and often you do not know what is going to appeal to your child, so instead of paying for toys that are not played with, why not come and borrow our toys?

Agreement

There is a £2 annual fee for families and a £10 annual fee for settings.

All toys are charged at 50p per hire.

All toys are loaned on a 2 week basis.

One toy per child per family can be borrowed at any one time.

If the toy you wish to borrow is already on loan you will be able to reserve it.

There are no late fees or charges, but if you would like to extend the loan of a toy please check with a member of staff that it has not already been reserved for someone else.

All toys borrowed from the Toy Library must be treated with care and respect. Please inform us of any breakages or missing pieces (there is no charge for damages).

Please be aware that many of the toys contain small parts which are not suitable for very young children. If you are not sure about a toys suitability just ask a member of staff who will be happy to advise you.
